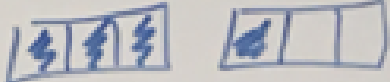


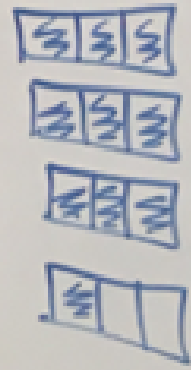


$$2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{4}{3}$$

$$4\frac{5}{9} \times 2\frac{1}{11}$$
